As you kick off a new year, choose to shake things up by adding a few spots to your San Diego drinking bucket list. We've done all the work for you and have narrowed it down to the five spots you should grab a drink at in 2016. Cheers!

Twist and “stout” your way to Common Theory Public House in Kearny Mesa. With a commitment to providing a wide selection of craft beers, Common Theory features over 30 rotating brews on

tap from San Diego breweries, as well as from breweries across the state and the country. Pair your beer with a snack from their menu, which boasts a fusion of California and ethnic cuisines.

Located on the edge of Hillcrest, Barrio Star is the place to get your margarita fix in 2016. The master margarita mixers have perfected drinks such as the Roasted Jalapeno Blackberry Margarita, with house-infused roasted jalapeno tequila, blackberry, fresh lime and agave. Grab a seat (and a drink!) and enjoy the modern Mexican Soul Food of Barrio Star.



Was your New Year's resolution to travel more in 2016? This year, journey to Italy without leaving San Diego. Newly opened at the corner of 6th and Broadway, Biga serves true Italian food and drinks in a fast-casual, upscale setting. Pull up a seat at the Italian marble countertop at the bar for a glass of wine or a craft beer. In the morning, take a seat at the bar and sip on a drink made on the state-of-the-art Italian espresso machine. The destination serves breakfast, lunch and dinner dishes, crafted from housemade and locally-sourced ingredients.

Showing a love for all things "San Diego," The Brew Project in Hillcrest is definitely one of the coolest bars for 2016. The spot features a rotating draft list of 24 beers from local San Diego breweries, craft cocktails made from locally-distilled spirits and SoCal-inspired cuisine. Grab a drink with friends on the open patio or take a seat at the bar inside while you catch a game on one of the HDTVs. With the Bottle Shop that allows visitors to purchase bottles of craft beer to-go, The Brew Project is sure to become an even hotter spot this year.

Travel back in time at the underground escape at ginger's in the Gaslamp. Located beneath the popular barleymash, ginger's is an ultra-hip lounge with dim lighting, an exceptional bar featuring martinis and craft cocktails and live music.
